

LHSA International Program Application Process 2009-2010 School Year

The *International Student Application* must be filled out and submitted with a copy of your transcript and any recommendation letters.

After the LHSA has received your application, we will make a decision as to whether or not you will be accepted into our program.

If you are accepted into our program, you will need to pay a \$600 I-20 fee, (non-refundable) and you will be issued a SEVIS I-20 that would be good for your remaining high school years.

Please note: We do not normally arrange for student housing or provide host families. The students in our program normally stay with relatives or friends of their family. In certain cases, they may have made arrangements with a U.S. family to be their host family. If your host family arrangements do not work out, there is no refund of any of the costs listed below:

Tuition:	\$7550

Total Tuition and fees: \$8600

A host family stipend of \$8000 (\$800 per month) is also required if the LHSA provides the host family.

A certificate of insurance must be provided by your International health insurance company)

One-half of the total amount due is payable by August 1, 2009.
The remainder is to be paid by December 1, 2009.

Payment should be wired or mailed to the LHSA.

Administrative costs include workbooks, lab fees, student activity fees, and other miscellaneous school expenses.

The above amount does not include airfare, local transportation, spending money, the noon meal at school, and some miscellaneous school expenses.
